



Sign up for the SAT/ACT!



Log on to or www.actstudent.org or www.collegeboard.org and create an account.

When filling out the registration, BE SURE your name, social security number and date of birth are correct.

Hillsborough Virtual's high school code is **102410**. You will need to upload a picture for your testing ticket printout. Your photo must be of just you, head & shoulders, facing front.

Choose at least ONE Florida public college to send your scores to; if you're not sure, choose HCC. If wait until after you've tested to send your test scores, it will cost between \$11 and \$15 for **each** college you send scores to.

Free/reduced lunch students are eligible for fee waivers. You're allowed 2 SAT and 2 ACT total over both your junior and senior year. College fee waivers (4) are also available on collegeboard.org.

Test Prep, Test Prep, Test Prep. You already have knowledge; now you need to learn to take the test. There are excellent FREE practice tests online: www.kahacademy.org has test prep and www.testprepreview.com and www.number2.com are great practice sites as well. The SAT and ACT are college placement tests and preparation can help you get the score you need. The more relaxed and ready you are on test day, the better your score!

What scores do I need?

To meet the graduation FCAT requirement, a score of 430 for SAT Reading or 19 on ACT Reading is needed. The minimum score for college level work is 440 on each section of the SAT or 19 Reading, 17 English and 19 Math on ACT. Most universities will deny or delay admission if test scores are below these minimums. The minimum for Bright Futures Medallion scholarship is 1170 SAT Reading and Math only (minimum 440 on each section) or 26 ACT; Bright Futures Academic is 1290 SAT and 29 ACT.
